

TEAS Entrance Exam Guide for ADN Applicants

The Navarro College Regional Testing Centers located in the Gooch One Stop Center on the Corsicana Campus, on the Waxahachie campus Building A, and on the Midlothian Campus, offer ongoing opportunities to take the Test of Essential Academic Skills (TEAS) exam each year. Call for appointment to test: Corsicana 903-875-7457, Waxahachie 972-923-6429, and Midlothian 972-775-7208.

This exam is used by the ADN, LVN, OTA, and PTA Health Professions Programs.

Navarro College offers the lowest fee possible for Navarro College Program applicants. *Payment (about \$58) must be made before your test.* The ADN Program will accept only one of the first two TEAS taken each academic year (September to August). ATI has two tests that are approx. \$46.00 each. Then a package with these tests and an assessment for approx. \$92.00.

The TEAS exam publisher is Assessment Technologies Institute (ATI). Go to atitesting.com to register for testing sites other than Navarro College. Hint:

This is a timed test. Read the instructions for each section of the exam. Pace yourself to assure completion of each section

If you wish to review your knowledge prior to taking the TEAS, find one of the free on-line college entrance exam practice tests and start there. If you are still concerned about the TEAS, purchase a TEAS study guide and take a TEAS practice test. **A Pre-Test Study Manual and online practice tests are available at atitesting.com.**

To be eligible to apply to the NC ADN program, you must score at or above the national mean for reading comprehension (currently 72.4) and math (currently 68.6.) on the one test that you submit. Only one of the first two TEAS exams completed in the last year will be accepted for admission purposes. The ADN Program uses the national norm for purposes of admission. Applicants who pass all four sections will be ranked first. However, on your TEAS form, please mark the type program (ADN) you plan to attend.

You keep the original of your TEAS results but email a copy of the first page only, with your ADN application page, and all unofficial transcripts to elizabeth.stroud@navarrocollege.edu
