

LVN Program

- ❖ 1-year program begins each August at each of the following campuses: Corsicana, Waxahachie, and Mexia
- ❖ Must be a graduate of an accredited high school or have a GED certificate
- ❖ Must apply and be admitted into Navarro College
- ❖ Must attend a MANDATORY information session in person- running from September-February (see www.navarrocollege.edu/technical/vn/ for dates and times and more information)
- ❖ Take and pass all parts of the ACCUPLACER (between March 1, 2009-February 25, 2010) and send the results to the Vocational Nursing Department (offered at all campuses- call the testing center to set up an appointment, cost is \$29) within 1 year prior to application- for a review go to: www.testprepreview.com

- ❖ Complete a criminal history background check and meet the requirements for clinical experience
- ❖ If the applicant meets the minimum requirements, he/she will receive an application (**deadline to request- February 26th**) to the Vocational Nursing Program as well as other pertinent data regarding admission.
- ❖ Please begin the Hepatitis B series of shots- a minimum of 2 shots should be completed by the time of application

Required Courses:

- No prerequisites are required, but math proficiency is advised before entry
- Each course in the LVN Program must be successfully completed with a minimum grade of 75 in order to proceed within the program

LVN RANKING:

Points are allotted as listed below

- 1) **ACCUPLACER test (minimum points = 75)**
 - Reading portion78
 - Writing portion Essay 6 or Essay 5/score 80
 - Math Portion (ElementaryAlgebra).....63

- 2) **Current health certification and/or work experience (within past 5 years)- official documentation must be provided (maximum points = 15)**
 - Medication Aide, EMT, Paramedic (or equivalent)15
 - Certified Nurses Aide10
 - Health Related Experience (vet, clinical, home health, etc...) 5

- 3) **Residency (maximum points = 5)**
 - In-service area (Navarro, Ellis, Limestone, Leon, or Freestone counties) 5
 - Out of service area 0

- 4) **Educational Background (maximum points = 30)**
 - 4 pre-req courses completed with a C or better (last 5 years)20
 - 3 pre-req courses completed with a C or better (last 5 years)15
 - 2 pre-req courses completed with a C or better (last 5 years)10
 - 1 pre-req course completed with a C or better (last 5 years) 5
 - Any 9 + college hours completed with a C or better10
 - Any 1-8 college hours completed with a C or better 5

NOTE: Pre-requisite courses for ADN Program include: BIOL 2401, BIOL 2402, PSYC 2301, and PSYC 2314
(SCIT courses do not count as pre-requisite courses)
