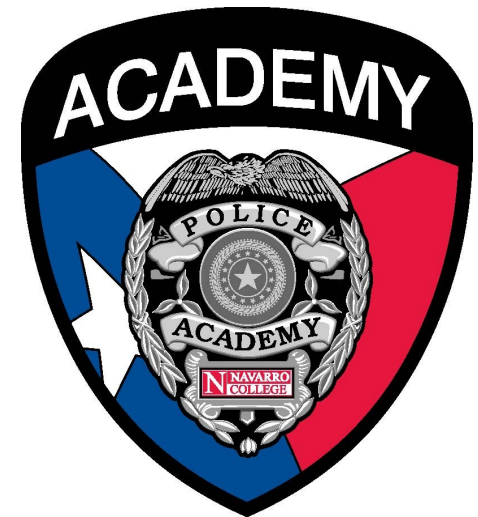

Basic Peace Officer Course

The **Basic Peace Officer Course** is a 680-hour program designed to prepare the student to pass the Peace Officer licensing exam given by TCLEOSE. Instruction in 29 topics ranging from two hours to 48 hours in length are covered during the course. Approximately one-fourth of the class is devoted to developing the physical skills required to become a peace officer.

ADMISSION STANDARDS —

- Must be 21 years of age by the time your class graduates, to be licensed.
- Applicants must pass a physical examination and a psychological examination.
- Possess High school diploma **OR** GED **OR** Home School diploma.
- Honorable discharge from the armed forces after at least 24 months of active duty service. You must not have been discharged from military service under less than honorable conditions
- No Class B Misdemeanor conviction in the past 10 years.
- No Class A Misdemeanor or felony conviction.
- No conviction of a family violence offense.
- You must not be prohibited from operating a motor vehicle.
- You must not be prohibited by state or federal law from possessing firearms or ammunition.

A complete criminal history will be conducted as part of the initial Registration Process when the FAST APPLICATION is submitted.

Registration Process

Prospective students should secure an information packet from the Corsicana Police Academy office or the Waxahachie Continuing Education/Protective Services Office.

Students MUST register prior to the first day of classes.

PRE-REGISTRATION

Admission (Office of Admissions & Records):

- Fill out application for admission to Navarro College:
www.navarrocollege.edu/admissions
- Submit High School diploma or GED and all required OFFICIAL transcripts ASAP.
- Copy of Driver's License and necessary proof of residency and citizenship.

Accuplacer Test

- Schedule and complete all portions of the Accuplacer Test at any NC campus. Bring test scores to Academy personnel.

FAST Application

- Complete the FAST application and follow directions on the form to obtain background check. There is a non-refundable fee of \$9.95 for the background check.

ONCE STUDENT RECEIVES CLEARANCE FROM THE ACADEMY REGARDING THE FAST APPLICATION/BACKGROUND CHECK, STUDENTS MAY PROCEED WITH THE "AFTER PRE-REGISTRATION".

AFTER PRE-REGISTRATION

Submit to either Academy office:

- NC Police Academy Application,
- A1-Authorization to Release Information & Waiver,
- Authorization to Share Information and Waiver,
- Copy of your Birth Certificate,
- Copy of high school diploma/GED/home school diploma,
- Copy of your driver's license—both sides,
- Copy of Military Discharge, if applicable.

Read the information on Veteran's Benefits and other types of grants and loans available.

Contact the Financial Aid office at the campus nearest you or drop by and visit with them for any questions you may have to begin the process.

Schedule Psychological Exam:

- Submit doctor completed L-3 Psychological Exam form.
