

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING
ON TAX INCREASE

A tax rate of \$0.1001 per \$100 valuation has been proposed by the governing body of NAVARRO COLLEGE (3).

PROPOSED TAX RATE	\$0.1001 per \$100
NO-NEW-REVENUE TAX RATE	\$0.0923 per \$100
VOTER-APPROVAL TAX RATE	\$0.1001 per \$100

The no-new-revenue tax rate is the tax rate for the 2025 tax year that will raise the same amount of property tax revenue for NAVARRO COLLEGE (3) from the same properties in both the 2024 tax year and the 2025 tax year.

The voter-approval rate is the highest tax rate that NAVARRO COLLEGE (3) may adopt without holding an election to seek voter approval of the rate.

The proposed tax rate is greater than the no-new-revenue tax rate. This means that NAVARRO COLLEGE (3) is proposing to increase property taxes for the 2025 tax year.

A PUBLIC HEARING ON THE PROPOSED TAX RATE WILL BE HELD ON September 9, 2025 AT 10:00 AM AT BULLDOG BOARD ROOM 3200 W 7TH AVE CORSICANA TEXAS 75110.

The proposed tax rate is not greater than the voter-approval tax rate. As a result, NAVARRO COLLEGE (3) is not required to hold an election at which voters may accept or reject the proposed tax rate. However, you may express your support for or opposition to the proposed tax rate by contacting the members of the NAVARRO COLLEGE BOARD OF TRUSTEES of NAVARRO COLLEGE (3) at their offices or by attending the public hearing mentioned above.

The 86th Texas Legislature modified the manner in which the voter-approval tax rate is calculated to limit the rate of growth of property taxes in the state.

The following table compares the taxes imposed on the average residence homestead by NAVARRO COLLEGE (3) last year to the taxes proposed to be imposed on the average residence homestead by NAVARRO COLLEGE (3) this year.

Total tax levy on all properties	\$7,516,268	\$8,767,432	increase of 1,251,164, or 16.65%
