## APPLICATION PROCESS

### 1<sup>ST</sup> STEP: Procedures for Admission to Navarro College

- Fill out application for admission to Navarro College at ApplyTexas on the [Navarro College.edu](http://NavarroCollege.edu) website.
- Submit OFFICIAL High School or College transcripts to the registrar's office.
- Submit Bacterial Meningitis Immunization paperwork to the registrar's office.
- Schedule and complete TSI Assessment test. (unless exempt)

### 2<sup>ND</sup> STEP: Registration for EMT Program

Registration must be completed with the Fire/EMS Dept. through the Academic Advisors on the Waxahachie Campus. Students are encouraged to frequently contact their Academic Advisors for progress in the registration process.

- CPR card is required by 1st day of class.  
Must be American Heart Healthcare Provider - offered at Navarro College through the Continuing Education Department in Building D.

## CURRENT IMMUNIZATIONS

- Hepatitis B - Complete series of three or Positive Titer\*\*
- Tuberculosis Test - blood test required yearly or inquire about skin test)
- Measles, Mumps, Rubella - Series of two shots needed or Positive Titer\*\*
- Varicella - 2 Shots or Positive Titer\*\*
- TDAP - shot must be current within 5 years
- Flu Shot - Current for Fall and Spring Classes  
(Info required: name, date, lot number, site of injection, signature of person administering the vaccine)
- Medical Release – Form is included in the registration packet

\*\*Titers to include IgG Lab value and interpretation key
